Alabama Supervision Regulations

Who needs this supervision training?

Alabama Board of Examiners in Counseling Administrative Rules state in Chapter 255-X-3-.03 the following requirements to be a qualified supervisor.

(3) Licensed professional counselors applying for supervising counselor status must comply with the following requirements:

- a. A minimum of five (5) years continuous full time (20+ hours per week) clinical practice as an LPC.
- b. Training. Document successful completion of ONE or more of the following supervisory training programs completed not more than three (3) years prior to submitting the application for Supervisor Counselor status:
 1. A passing grade at an accredited college or university in an academic course specific to supervision of counselors
 2. Supervision certification by one, or more, of the following clinical associations (AAMFT Approved Supervisor, AAPC-Diplomat, AMHCA Approved Supervisor, NBCC Approved Clinical Supervisor).
 3. Any Alabama Board of Examiners in Counseling (ABEC) approved supervisory training event, for a minimum of 24 contact hours. Board approval must be requested (30) or more days prior to the scheduled training event, and must be accompanied by a program description and qualifications of the instructor.

Glenn continues to provide clinical supervision as part of his private practice. Glenn specializes in working with clients who have co-occurring substance use disorders, depressive disorders, and anxiety disorders. Glenn served as an expert panel member for a SAMHSA TIPS book on treating sub-acute anxiety in the substance using population.

Since 1999, Glenn has also specialized in, and has developed a 24 to 45 hour workshop series clinical supervision. He is a leading behavioral healthcare lecturer on clinical supervision. Since 1999, he has continuously developed and taught this clinical supervision curriculum for Rutgers University among other organizations. He has consulted with organizations on how to enhance and implement best practice clinical supervision strategies. Glenn authored a chapter on the use of live supervision in a community treatment organization for the book entitled "The Use of Technology in Clinical Supervision and Training: Mental Health Applications," published in 2016.
