Michigan Supervision Training Requirements

Who needs this supervision training?

From HB4325/PA96 (Now Sec. 333.18106 which is effective as of 01/27/20): "A licensed professional counselor shall not supervise a limited licensed counselor without completing training in supervision as required by rules promulgated by the department [LARA] in consultation with the board [of counseling]."

The new Michigan Administrative rules (R 338.1751 - R 338.1781) took place May 5, 2021. The requirements to provide counseling supervision are listed in Rule 81:

(2) Training in the function of counseling supervision shall include the following requirement:

- a. Include 1 of the following as specialized training:
- . 2 semester hours of graduate credit in training in counseling supervision.
- ii. 30 contact hours of workshop training in counseling supervision.

Michigan LPCs scope of practice now includes a new supervision statute. The new statute 333.18106 requires that LPC's must obtain training in supervision. On May 5, 2021 LARA Board of Counseling officially stated 30 hours of supervision training is required (R 338.1781, Rule 81). This training will cover up to 45 hours of NBCC approved continuing education, which definitively meets the newly revised Michigan supervision education requirements in R 338-1781 Rule 81.
