- Workshop participants will be able to identify the origins of racial classifications in the US and how they are currently defined.
- Workshop participants will be able to list at least two questions to help ascertain an organization's cultural competence.

This is a requirement of many NJ licensing boards or committees, for example, professional counselors, social workers and substance use counselors (see how I did that alphabetically) receive 3 hours of biennial training in this area. Many other state's licensure or certification boards also have this requirement.

This workshop will have participants looking into various issues of counseling as it pertains to the work of a counselor/therapist. Cultural competence is a healthcare standard that was established decades ago and implemented, on some level, by the requirement of licensees/certificate holders to obtain continuing education in this area. Cultural humility was developed in 1998 to address this area in a lensing it felt "cultural competence" either didn't address. This workshop will blend both concepts and address how each is important in the work within the behavioral healthcare field.
