WORKSHOP OBJECTIVES

1. Define the core principles of Motivational Interviewing (MI) by correctly identifying its purpose and distinguishing it from other counseling approaches in group discussion.
2. Describe the four components of the MI Spirit (partnership, acceptance, compassion, evocation) by listing and giving at least one example of each.
3. Differentiate between sustain talk and discord by describing how each signals different clinical implications in small-group discussion.
4. Identify client language that represents change talk (DARN-CAT) versus sustain talk or discord by accurately categorizing at least three sample statements.
5. Identify the four recursive processes in MI4, engaging, focusing, evoking and planning, and list at least one technique that can be used in each recursive process.

Attendees will build confidence in using MI strategies to determine level of readiness and utilize DARN-CAT/OARS.
